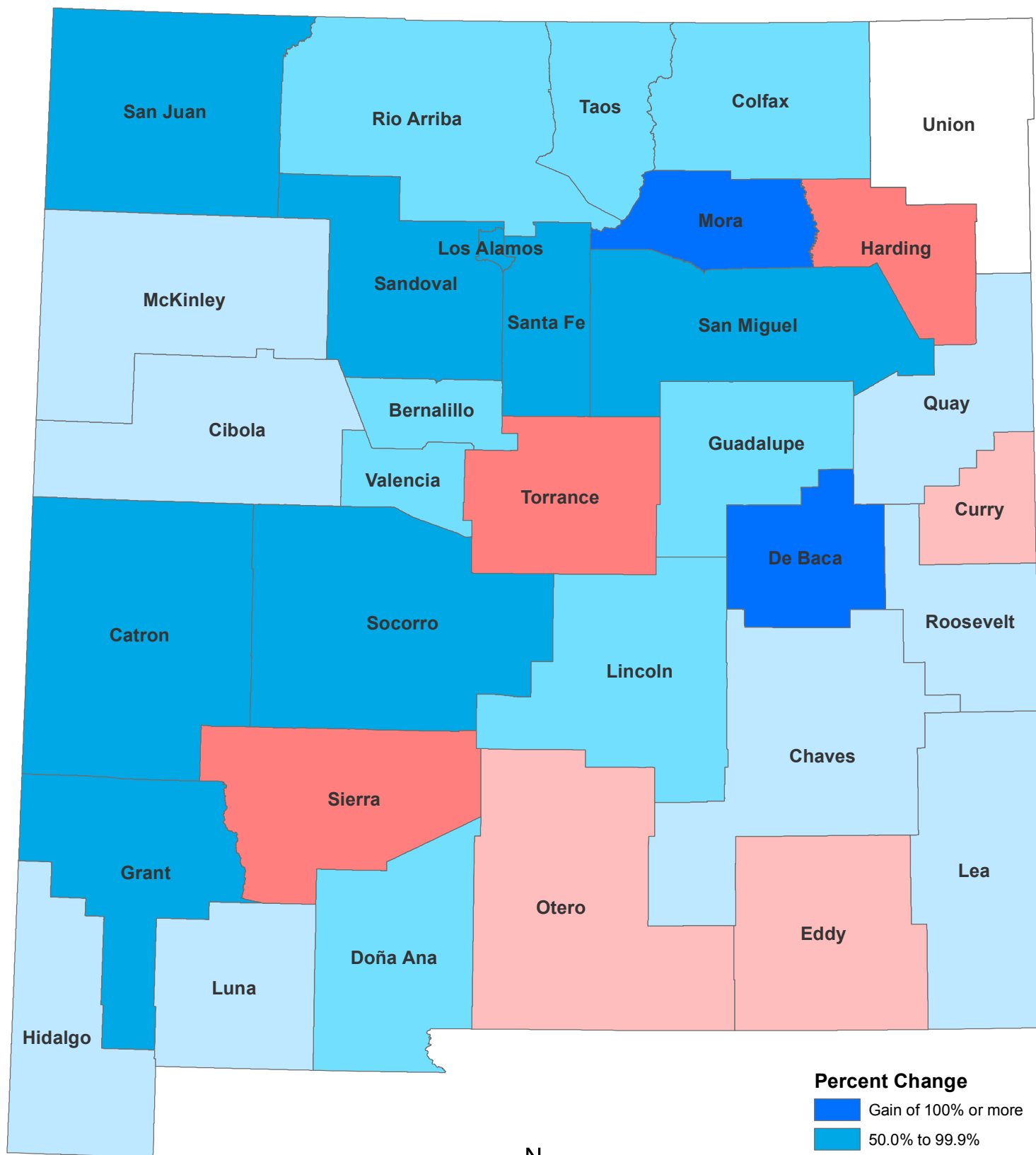
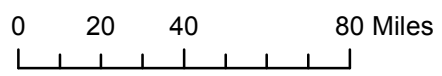


# Percent Change, 2000 to 2010 One Race: Black or African American



NM change is 23.9%

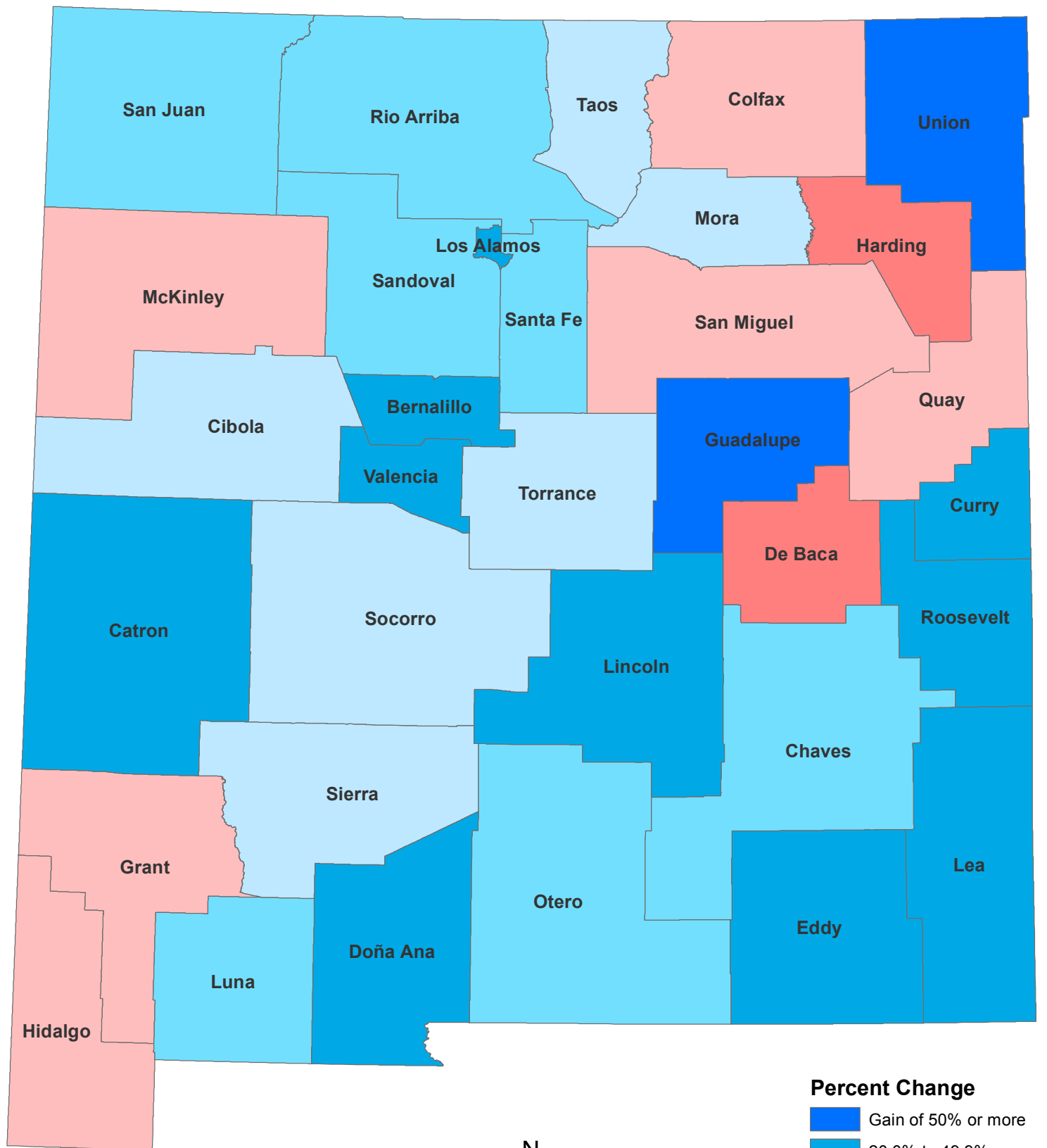

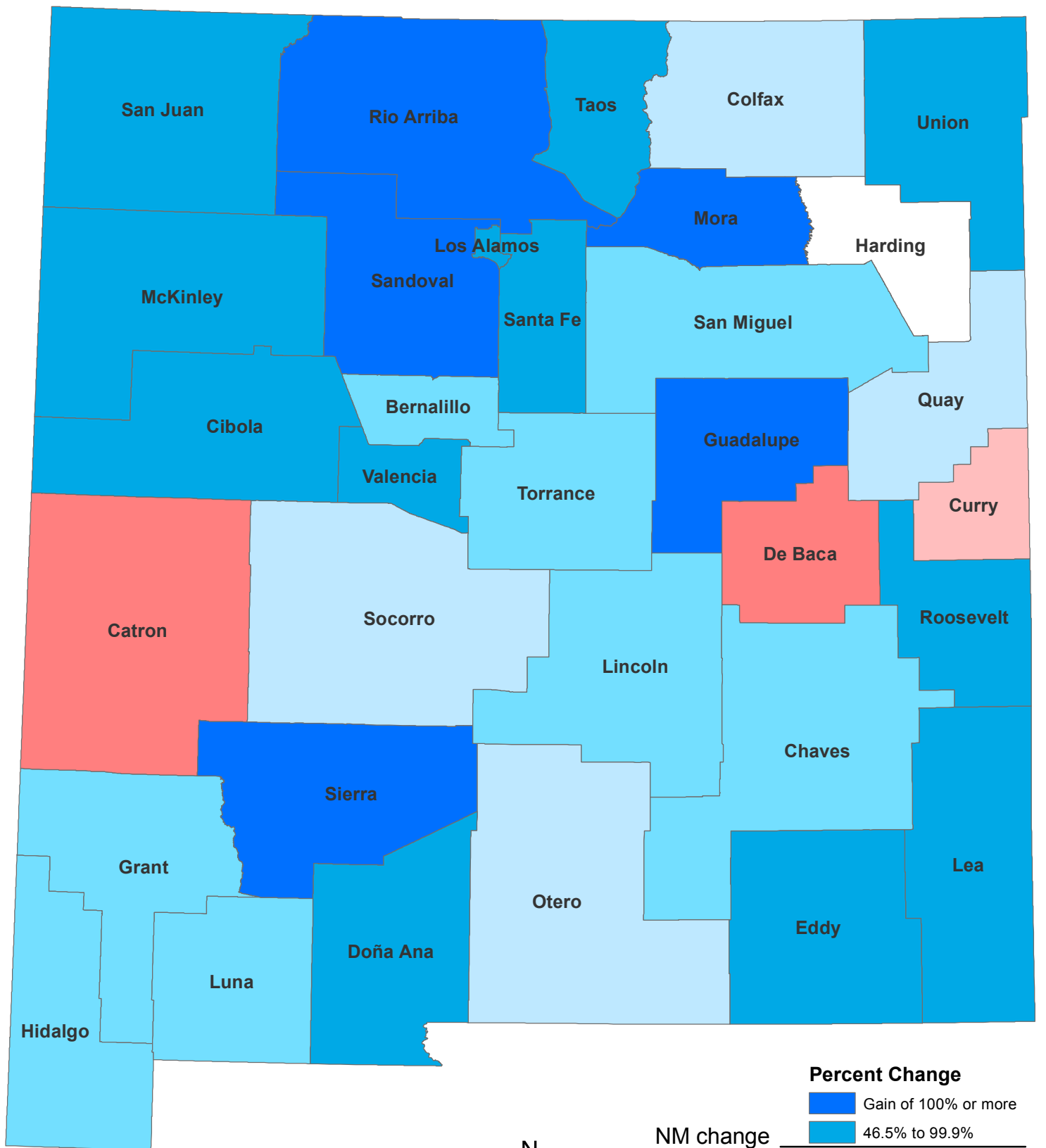

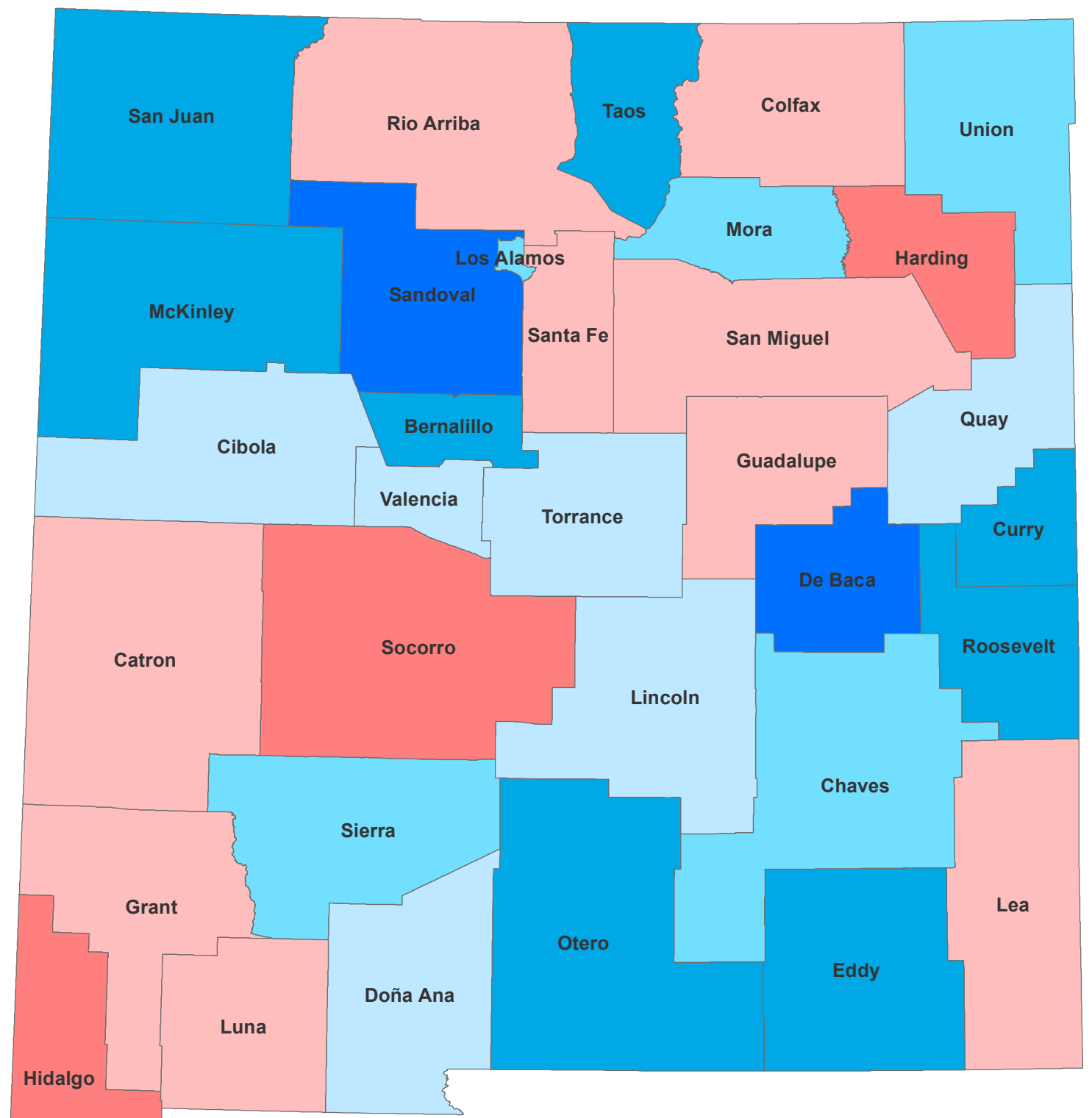

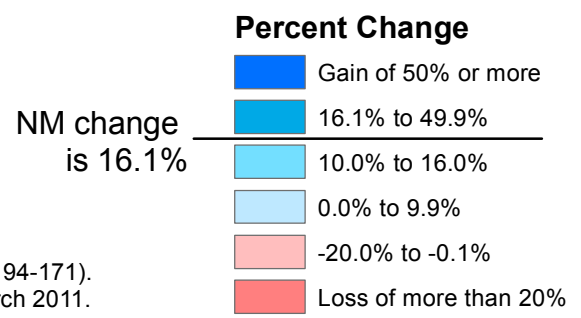

# Percent Change, 2000 to 2010 Two or More Races

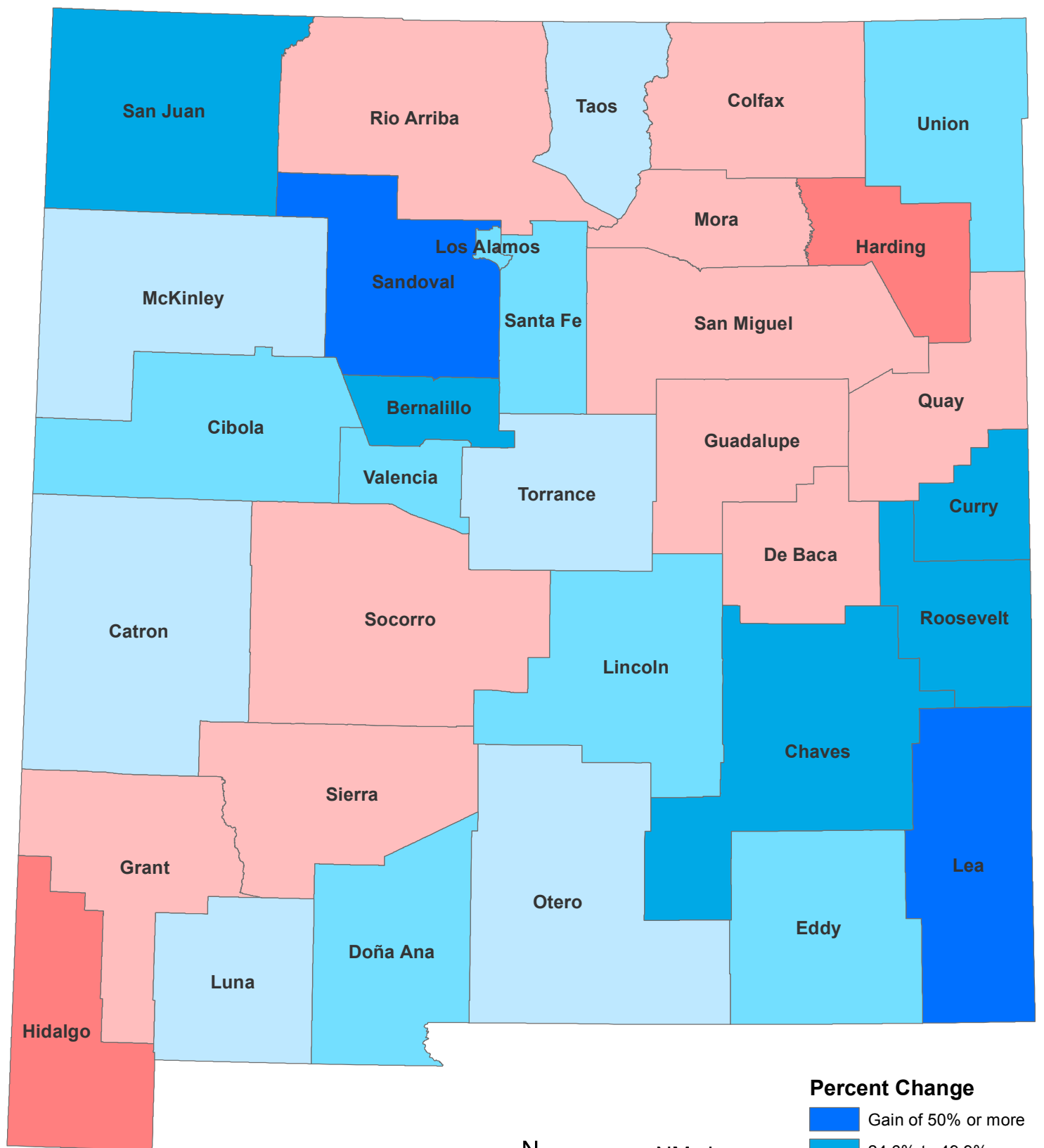

# Percent Change, 2000 to 2010 Hispanic or Latino

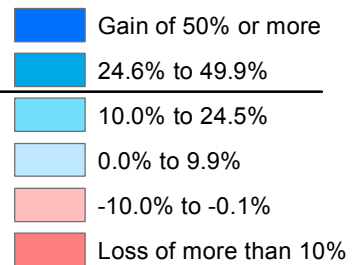

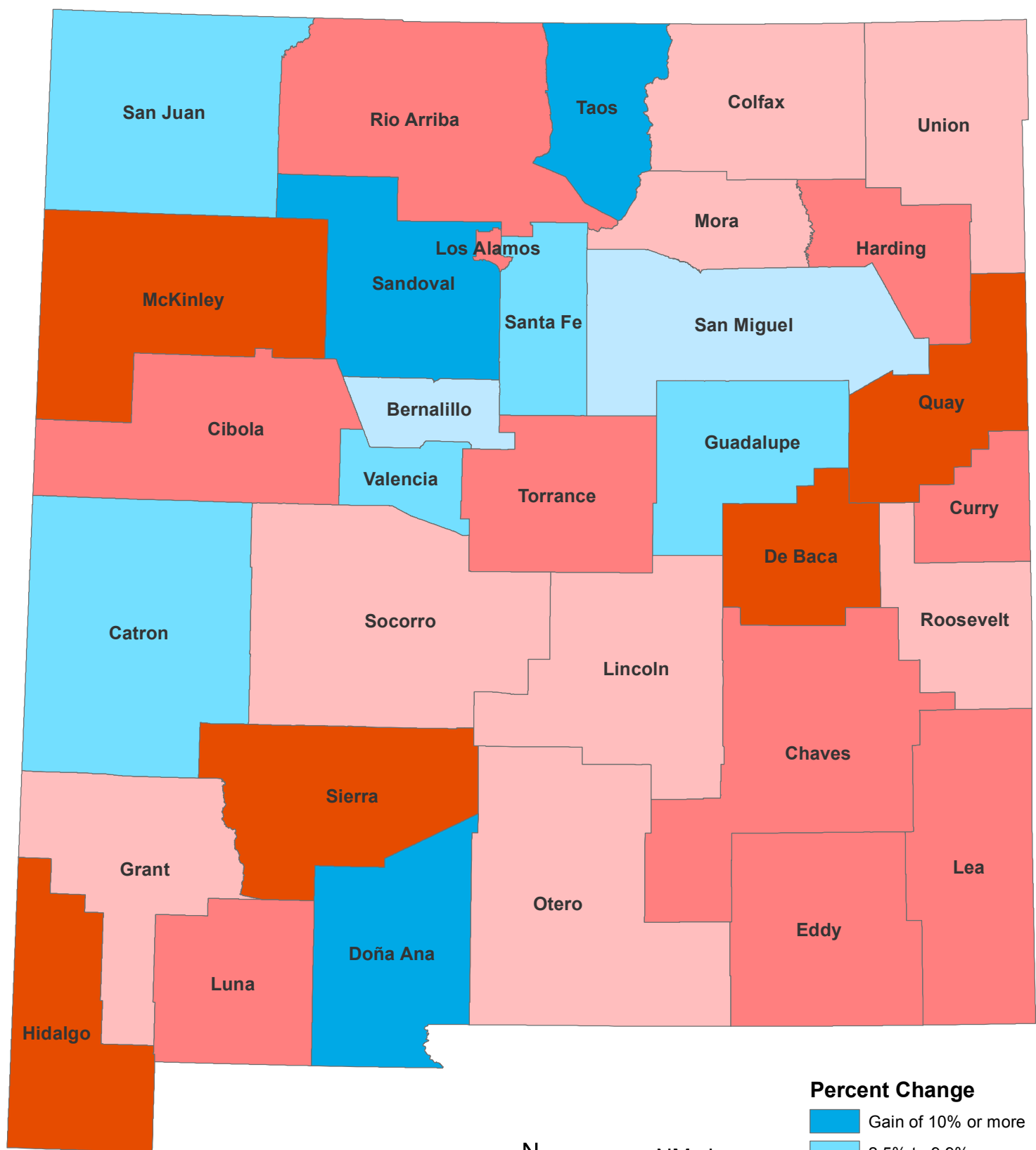

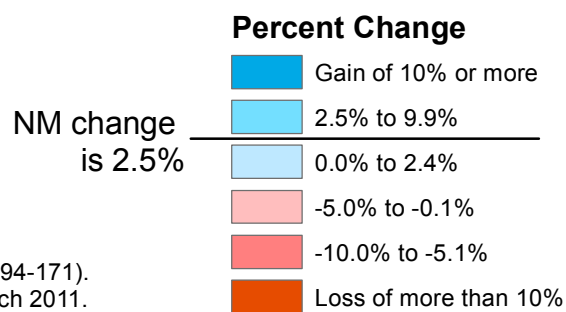
